COMPUTER APPLICATIONS Vs ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE:

COMPUTER APPLICATIONS (165): Other Academic Elective

Computer Applications (Code – 165) is an additional subject

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (417) Skill Subject

If a student fails in any one of the three compulsory academic subjects (i.e. Science, Mathematics and Social Science) and passes in the Skill subject (offered as 6th optional subject), then it will be replaced by the Skill subject and result of Class X Board examination will be computed accordingly.

Two levels of Mathematics for Class -IX.
Mathematics Standard (Code-041)
Mathematics Basic (Code-241)

Standard level: This is the existing level of syllabus and examination. This level will be meant for students who **wish to opt for Mathematics at Senior Secondary Level.**

Basic level: There will be **no change in syllabus**, classroom teaching and internal assessments for this level but the **final examination paper would be of an easier level**. The Basic level would be for students who are **not keen to pursue Mathematics at higher levels.**
